**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 (FOI): REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
M25 JUNCTION 19 ACCESS SLIP ROAD**

Thank you for your letter of 24 October concerning the trial new road layout on the slip road at junction 19 of the M25.

The information you have requested is as follows;

- The flow data on which the statistical information (economic assessment) is based was collected for the M25 anticlockwise carriageway before the on slip at J19 and the M25 Link Road at J19.
- Count on us (www.count-on-us.co.uk) was commissioned by the Highways Agency to carry out a video survey during the am peak between 7:00hrs/10:00hrs and the pm peak between 15:00hrs/19:00hrs. Data was collected Monday to Friday on the following week(s); between 19th and 23rd February 2007 (before trial) and between 26th February and 23 March 2007 (during trial).

I must apologise that the information provided to you in my letter of the 20 June has not been added to the HA web page. I have made arrangements for this to be undertaken.

In keeping with the spirit and effect of the Freedom of Information Act, all information is assumed to be releasable to the public unless exempt. We will, therefore, be simultaneously releasing to the public the information you requested, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context via our website: <http://www.highways.gov.uk/>
