A1(M) JUNCTION 4-6 WORKS

Thank you for your e-mails to the Highways Agency's Information Line (HAIL ref: 488210) and the follow up e-mail to Gill Capocciana from our Managing Agent regarding the A1(M) resurfacing.

You asked us to clarify what works have been carried out on the A1(M) between Junctions 4 and 6 and what assessment has been made of noise for the residents.

Please find attached two documents.

- 1) A map showing where the carriageway resurfacing works have been completed. The area highlighted blue shows the resurfacing that has been completed using thin wearing course system that classifies as low noise material. The area highlighted red shows the sections of the carriageway that are still in sound condition.
