Thank you for your request for information about translation services. Your request was received on 7 April 2008 and has been dealt with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

In that request, you asked us to provide details of how much the Highways Agency spent on translation services into (i) Welsh and (ii) other languages in 2006-07.

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information, which you requested.

- (i) There have been no translations into Welsh.
- (ii) £3,641.72 spent on translations into other languages
