ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION REGULATIONS 2004

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information, which you requested on 28 April.

The changes to the bridle path at Fairy Hill Lane were made under the provisions of the M62 (Lofthouse-South of Ferrybridge Side Roads) Order 1971. The bridle path was stopped up to allow construction of the motorway and to compensate a new footpath and bridle path was constructed alongside the motorway to lead to Spittal Hardwick Lane.

Notices about this would almost certainly have been posted on site but I cannot confirm that they were as there is now no existing record of where or if the notices were posted.

I enclose an extract from the Order for your perusal and a plan showing that the existing arrangements match the Order.

In keeping with the spirit and effect of the Freedom of Information Act, all information is assumed to be releasable to the public unless exempt.
