FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Further to your recent letter dated 2 June 2008 requesting the access to Road Safety Audit reports for Ramp Metering schemes on M25 Junctions 6 & 8.

As a result of delivery dates of the above mentioned sites being re-scheduled to autumn 2008, the publication date of Road Safety Audits has also been changed. At the time of writing, the planned release date is expected to be August 2008, but may be subject to further revision if the delivery dates were to be set forward again.

In order to fulfil your request for access, the Public Interest Test (PIT) documented in the previous correspondence was revisited with the view of releasing the Road Safety Audit report prematurely. The review identified that the factors supporting the decision not to release ahead of scheme delivery have not changed and therefore the previous PIT result still stands and the information continues to be withheld under section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act.

Meanwhile, I understand that there are a number of observations and concerns related to the proposed schemes you would wish to share and these would be much appreciated. Rather than continue to exchange letters, this being the fourth response, perhaps you would find it helpful if we could arrange to meet? Please feel free to contact me either by email or the telephone number provided, if this meets with your approval.
