The table below shows the breakdown of costs based upon the ministerial approved budget.

Item	Cost (£m)
Works (including preparation, supervision and risk).	36.02
Land	3.25
Non-recoverable VAT	2.81
Total	42.08

The Bypass is funded by Government as part of the transport budget and there have been no contributions from private companies.
