## **ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION REGULATIONS : REQUEST FOR MOTORWAY LENGTHS**

I confirm that we have now completed our search for the information you requested on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2009.

I clarified your request with you on 12<sup>th</sup> June and you confirmed that you wanted the information for 1999, 2003, 2005 and 2007.

I have dealt with your request under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. This is because the information requested concerns measures and activities affecting or likely to affect elements of the environment or affect factors such as noise, pollution discharges and other releases into the environment.
