COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND AND NEW RIGHTS: IN THE PARISHES OF ALCONBURY, BRAMPTON, BUCKDEN, ELLINGTON, FENSTANTON, HEMINGFORD ABBOTS, HEMINGFORD GREY AND OFFORD CLUNY AND THE TOWNS OF GODMANCHESTER AND HUNTINGDON ALL IN THE DISTRICT OF HUNTINGDONSHIRE; IN THE PARISHES OF BAR HILL, BOXWORTH, CONINGTON, DRY DRAYTON, FEN DITTON, FEN DRAYTON, GIRTON, HORNINGSEA, IMPINGTON, LOLWORTH, LONGSTANTON, MADINGLEY, MILTON, OAKINGTON AND WESTWICK AND SWAVESEY ALL IN THE DISTRICT OF SOUTH CAMBRIDGESHIRE; IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE; ALL IN THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIDGESHIRE

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has prepared in draft the A14 Trunk Road (Ellington to Fen Ditton Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (MP No. ) 20 under sections 239, 240 and 246 of the Highways Act 1980. He is about to make this Order, and if made, the Order will authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights described below for the purpose of :

- a) the construction of the new trunk roads: in the Parishes of Alconbury, Brampton, Buckden, Ellington, Fenstanton, Hemingford Abbots, Hemingford Grey and Offord Cluny and the Towns of Godmanchester and Huntingdon all in the District of Huntingdonshire; in the Parishes of Bar Hill, Boxworth, Conington, Dry Drayton, Fen Ditton, Fen Drayton, Girton, Horningsea, Impington, Lolworth, Longstanton, Madingley, Milton, Oakington and Westwick and Swavesey all in the District of South Cambridgeshire; in the City of Cambridge; all in the County of Cambridgeshire in pursuance of the A14 Trunk Road (Ellington to Fen Ditton Improvement) Order 20 ;

- b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in those parishes, towns, districts and city in pursuance of the A14 Trunk Road (Ellington to Fen Ditton Improvement Side Roads) Order 20 ;
- c) the improvement of the A14 Trunk Road in those parishes, towns, districts and city;
- d) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk roads and the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;
- e) use by the Secretary of State for Transport in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and
- f) the mitigation of any adverse effects which the existence or use of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved will have on their surroundings.

Any objection to the draft Compulsory Purchase Order must be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State at the offices of the Highways Agency, Woodlands, Manton Lane, Manton Industrial Estate, Bedford MK41 7LW to arrive before 6 January 2010 and should state the title of the Order and quote reference HA 65/9/369. It should give the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of the grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
