Accident statistics quoted exclude accidents that occurred at or within 20m of a junction.

The collision rate for the M42 Junction 3A to Junction 7 between the dates of 09/06/1998 to 08/06/2003 is 11.6 per 100 million vehicle miles travelled. Before construction.

The collision rate for the M42 Junction 3A to Junction 7 between the dates of 01/02/2006 to 31/07/2006 is 6.4 per 100 million vehicle miles travelled. During construction.

The collision rate for the M42 Junction 3A to Junction 7 between the dates of 01/02/2006 to 31/07/2009 is 4.8 per 100 million vehicle miles travelled. After construction.

The collision rate for the time period before the works, during the works and after the works started are all below the 2007-2009 National Average Collision Rate on Motorways, which is 11.7* per 100 million vehicle miles travelled.
