The collision rate for the M6 Junction 8 to Junction 10a between the dates of 01/11/2006 to 31/10/2009 is 14.1 per 100 million vehicle miles travelled. Before construction.

The collision rate for the time period before the works started is above the 2007-2009 National Average Collision Rate on Motorways, which is 11.7* per 100 million vehicle miles travelled.
