Scene starts with a surgeon and nurse walking into an operating theatre

Voice Over: People deserve our respect for the work that they do.

Classroom scene with a teacher and children in an arts and crafts class

VO: to make our lives more informed,

Road workers putting out cones

VO: more reliable and safe

Forward-looking view from a car approaching road works

VO: Drivers who ignore warning signs and speed limits

Cars speedometer doing 70mph and increasing  
Image of road workers repairing a central barrier

VO: kill or injure road workers every year

Car approaching by road works

VO: when all they're doing

Through the windscreen of a car you can see some road workers

VO: is their job

The car swerves into and through the cones

Back to the operating theatre and the car comes crashing through the wall

Back the school scene where the children are playing. The car comes smashing through the wall sending the children running for safety.

From the view inside the car you can see a road worker hitting the windscreen after the car collides with him.

A shot of a pot falling and breaking in the classroom.

On the road cones are strewn over the road and you can see the road worker lying on the ground in front of the stationary car as other road workers come running to help.

Fade to black and the image appears across the screen
