# Public Consultation

On 6th April 2005 the Highways Agency postponed the exhibitions being held in connection with the public consultation for the A14 Ellington to Fen Ditton scheme, in accordance with Guidance on Communications during a General Election campaign issued by the Cabinet Office.

However, the public consultation process is continuing as planned. The remaining exhibitions have now been re-arranged, starting on Tuesday 17th May 2005 in Buckden. Full details of the exhibition venues, dates and times are shown below.
