NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a local Pre-Inquiry Meeting will be held in relation to the Secretary of State for Transport's proposal for the orders listed above.

THE LOCAL PRE-INQUIRY MEETING will be presided over by an Inspector appointed on the nomination of the Planning Inspectorate, by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government and the Secretary of State for Transport for the purposes of conducting Inquiries into the above orders.

THE MEETING will be held on a time and a date to be advised at the Slaugham Manor Training and Conference Centre, Staplefield Road, Slaugham, RH17 6AJ. All persons with an interest in the Public Inquiries are invited to attend.

THE MEETING will be held in accordance with Rule 5 of the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994 and Rule 5 of the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT direct that any person who intends at the Inquiries to submit –

- (a) that any highway or proposed highway to which the draft Order at 1 above relates should follow an alternative route, or
- (b) that instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway in accordance with the draft Side Roads at 2 above, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route,

shall send to them at the Highways Agency, Major Projects South, Room 2A, Federated House, London Road, Dorking Surrey, RH4 1SZ not later than 27th March 2009 sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the person holding the Inquiries and the Secretaries of State to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
