



## A419 Commonhead Junction Improvement Forthcoming Traffic Management Works

The works to the Commonhead Junction Improvement scheme moves into a new phase in the New Year. This will include major traffic management measures for around 15 months. We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause and every effort will be made to ensure that any disruption is kept to a minimum.

To allow safe construction of the works and access for vehicles to the site, the major traffic management will be 2 narrower lanes on all of the A419 approaches with a 40mph speed limit, enforced by speed cameras. The third (offside) lane at each A419 roundabout approach will be removed as well as one lane on the roundabout and Marlborough Road. Cyclists wishing to travel along the A419 through Commonhead are therefore advised that alternative routes should be sought while the traffic management is in place.

The work required to install the major traffic management will be carried out in two phases.

<u>Phase</u>	<u>Works</u>	<u>Dates</u>
1	Installation of signs and changes to road markings	Sat 14 <sup>th</sup> Jan Sun 15 <sup>th</sup> Jan (provisional)
2	Installation of temporary safety barriers	Mon 23 <sup>rd</sup> to Thur 26 <sup>th</sup> Jan

Both phases will need to be carried out at night for safety and traffic reasons. Please note that the dates for carrying out the work may vary depending on weather conditions or other factors outside the control of the site team

Additionally, the lay-by immediately to the south of the roundabout and the one way access to Day House Lane will be permanently closed. This will take effect from the 14<sup>th</sup> January
