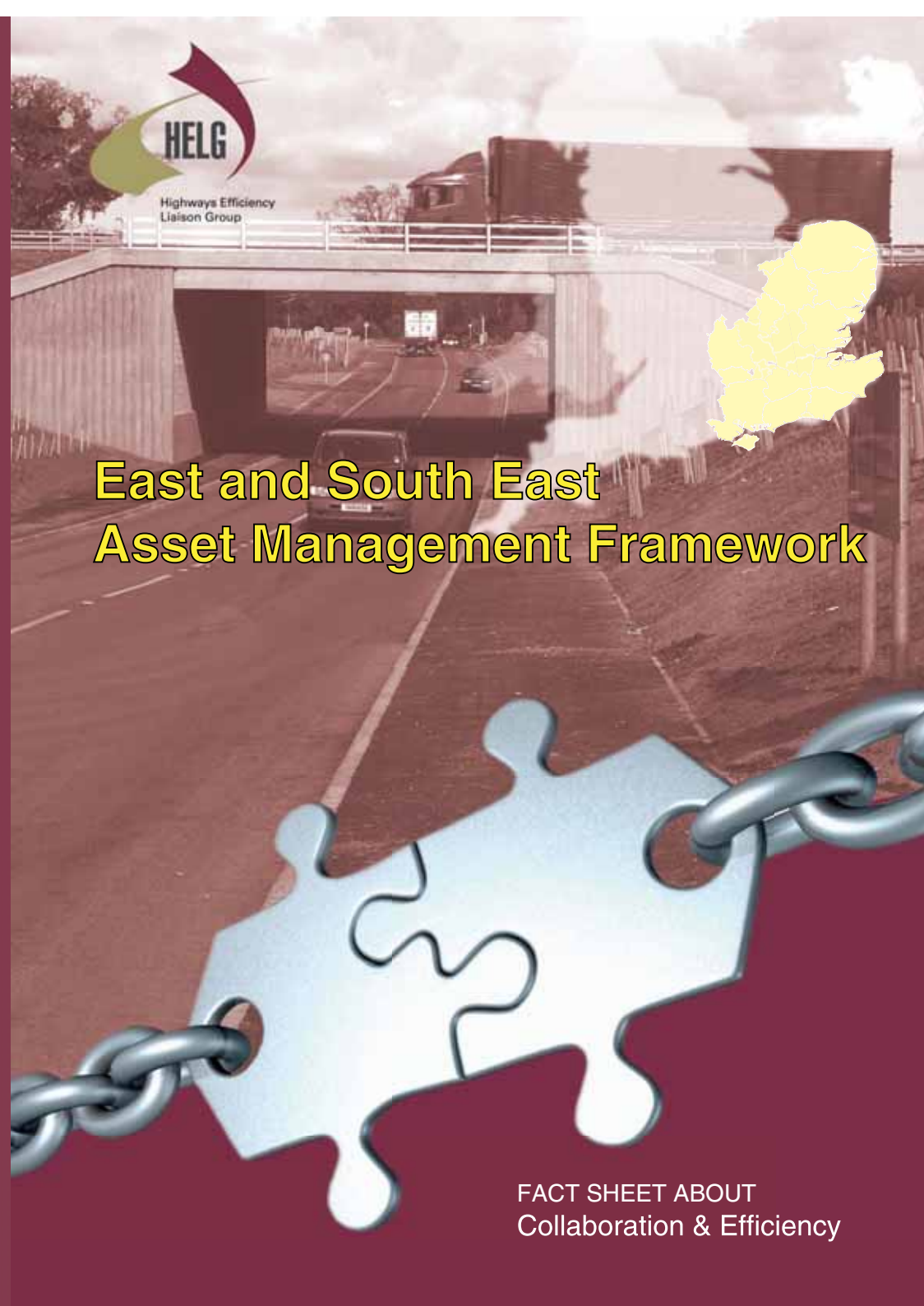

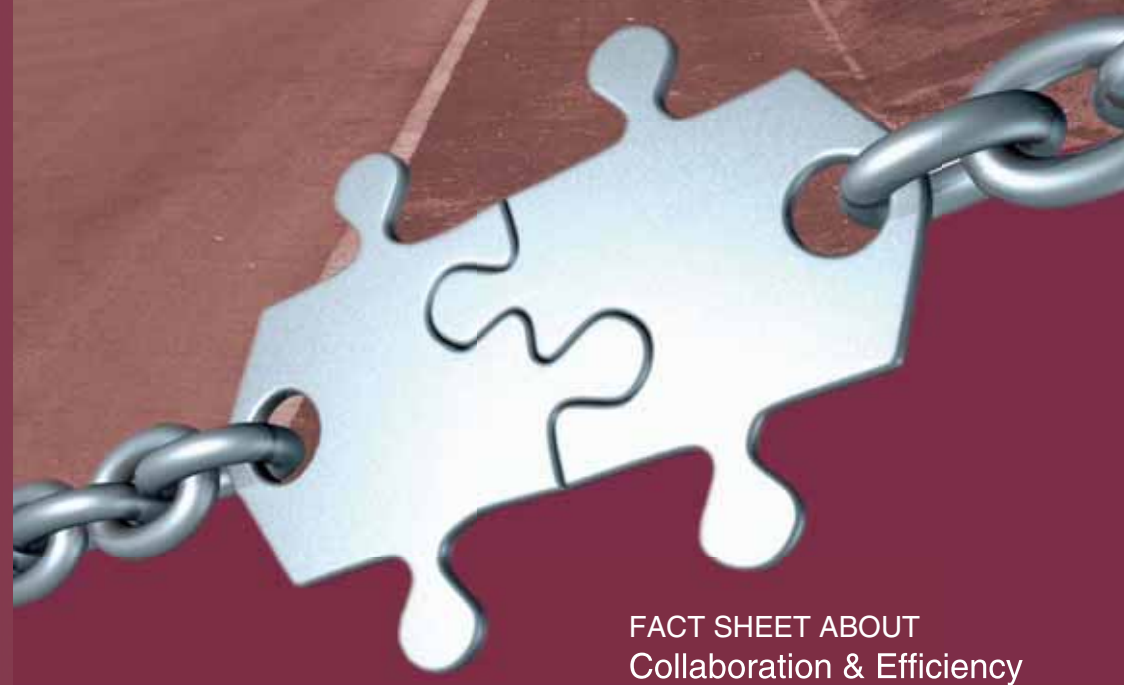

Introduction

The **Highways Agency's East & South East Asset Management Framework** was awarded in July 2009 and has a duration of up to four years (two years, plus up to a further two years based on performance and the Highways Agency's strategic needs).

The Framework is available for use by Local Highways Authorities and Government Agencies covering general highways and structures maintenance and improvement and technology schemes up to £10 million in value.

Planning for Success

The Framework gives early access to Suppliers with proven experience in delivering:

- Site surveys and investigations: geotechnical, environmental and structural
- Value engineering, buildability and design for maintenance
- Early involvement resulting in increased delivery speeds
- Building in safety and elimination of risks
- Financial benefits of competitive costs and cost predictability
- Best Practice Approach through shared knowledge & experience
- Support in all aspects of construction, programming and budgetary support.

This Framework will help you:
