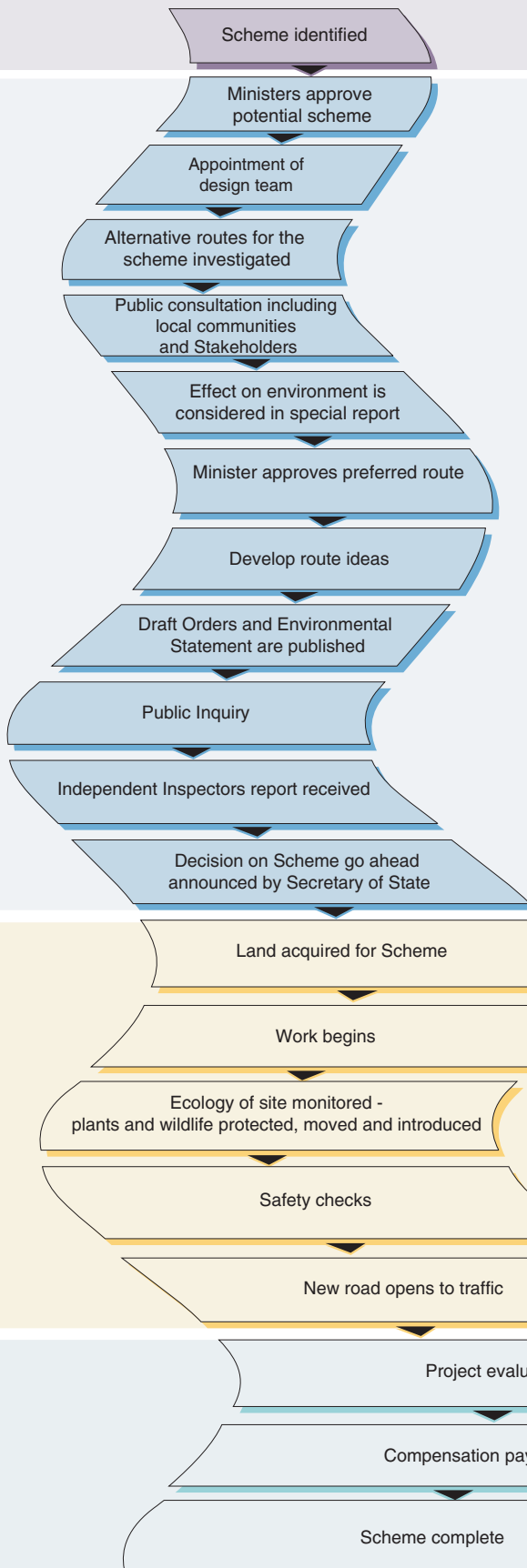


# HOW WE BUILD A ROAD

## PLANNING STAGE

We have reduced dramatically the time it takes to open a road scheme.

It used to be 12 - 15 years but using various techniques, such as involving contractors much earlier in the process, we have brought it down to seven years.

Here's how a typical scheme goes from an idea on paper to a completed road scheme which can relieve congestion and improve safety.
