HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE M1 MOTORWAY (JUNCTIONS 10 TO 13 IMPROVEMENT SIDE
ROADS) ORDER 20..

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 12, 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the M1 Motorway Junctions 10 to 13 Improvement in Central Bedfordshire and the County of Bedfordshire, which will:

- (1) authorise him to –
 - (a) improve highways,
 - (b) stop up highways,
 - (c) construct new highways,
 - (d) stop up private means of access to premises,
 - (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of Junctions 11 and 12 along the route of the M1 Motorway Junctions 10 to 13 Improvement mentioned above; and

COPIES of each draft Order and the plans referred to in it, and of the environmental statement which the Secretary of State has published in relation to the construction of the new highways and the improvement of existing highways referred to in the draft Order, may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 2nd December 2009 until 27th January 2010, or within 8 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, at the Highways Agency, 5 Broadway, Broad Street, Birmingham B15 1BL; the Highways Agency, Woodlands, Manton Lane, Manton Lane Industrial Estate, Bedford MK 41 7LW; Government Office for the East of England, Eastbrook, Shaftesbury Road, Cambridge CB2 8DF; Luton Borough Council, Town Hall, George Street, Luton LU1 2BQ; Central Bedfordshire Council, The Council Offices, High Street North, Dunstable LU6 1NF; Flitwick Town Council, The Rufus Centre, Steppingley Road, Flitwick MK41 1AH; Toddington Parish Council Office, Leighton Road, Toddington LU5 6AN; Dunstable Town Council, Grove House, 76 High Street, Dunstable LU6 1NF; Harlington Parish Council, The Parish Office, Church Road, Harlington, Dunstable LU5 6LE.

ANY PERSON MAY OBJECT to the making of any of the Order not later than 27th January 2010, or within 8 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, by notice to the Secretary of State at the offices of the Highways Agency, 5 Broadway, Broad Street, Birmingham, B15 1BL, quoting reference HA/065/018/002066 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
