THE M1 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 13 SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2008

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby gives notice that she has made the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 16, 17 and 19 of the Highways Act 1980, entitled The M1 Motorway (Junction 13 and Connecting Roads) Order 2008, which:-
  - (1) authorises her to provide for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980, four special roads (slip roads) to connect the M1 Motorway at Junction 13 with other highways at Husborne Crawley in the County of Bedfordshire; and
  - (2) provides for each of the new special roads to become a trunk road on the date the Order comes into force.
2. An Order under section 18 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the M1 Motorway entitled The M1 Motorway (Junction 13 Side Roads) Order 2008 at Husborne Crawley in the County of Bedfordshire which will authorise her to stop up the four existing motorway slip roads.

COPIES of the decision letter (and the Inspectors Report following public inquiry) and a copy of each Order and the plans referred to in it have been deposited at the Highways Agency, Woodlands, Manton Lane, Bedford, MK41 7LW; Wootton Library, Lorraine Road, Wootton, Bedfordshire, MK43 9LH (Opening times; Monday 2 – 6pm, Wednesday 10am – 1pm & 2 – 6pm, Friday 2 - 6pm and Saturday 10am – 1pm) and Bedford Central Library, Harpur Street, Bedford, MK40 1PG where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED by an Order mentioned in this notice who desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision in it, on the ground that:

- (a) it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or
- (b) any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to that Order,



may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice. On such an application, the Court may suspend or quash that Order or any provision in it.
