

Weekend Closure - No access to Hemel Hempstead to/from M1 Junction 8

from 10pm on Friday 7 March
until 5am Monday 10 March 2008

As part of the major M1 widening scheme, the bridge at M1 junction 8 will be demolished. This closure is necessary for important work that will enable drivers to use a new bridge and slip roads before demolition of the existing bridge.

Diversion

- A414 Breakspear Way between Green Lane and M1 will be closed in both directions
- A414 Breakspear Way eastbound will be open between Maylands Avenue and Green Lane roundabout for local access only
 - All drivers from Hemel Hempstead wishing to join the M1 northbound at junction 8 will be diverted from Maylands Avenue to junction 9 on the M1 via the B487 and A5183
 - All drivers wishing to join the M1 southbound at junction 8 will be diverted through Hemel Hempstead via the A41 to junction 20 of the M25 and then via the M25 to junction 21a to rejoin the M1 southbound at Junction 6
- Local access to the Shell and BP garages and the Holiday Inn will be maintained during this closure
- M1 northbound and southbound “through traffic” will not be affected
