ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

- 1. THE A45 TRUNK ROAD (A45/A46 TOLLBAR END JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT) ORDER 200\_.**
- 2. THE A45 TRUNK ROAD (A45/A46 TOLLBAR END JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 200\_.**
- 3. THE A45 TRUNK ROAD (A45/A46 TOLLBAR END JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER (MP NO. XX) 200\_.**
- 4. CERTIFICATE UNDER PARAGRAPH 6(1) (c) OF SCHEDULE 3 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Public Local Inquiries will be held at the Holiday Inn, Coventry South, London Road, Ryton on Dunsmore, Coventry CV8 3DY, starting at 10:00 am on 26 January 2010 into:

1. The Secretary of State for Transport's proposal to make the Orders listed below, and into the objections which he has received in connection with that proposal; and
2. The proposal by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government to grant a certificate under paragraph 6 of Schedule 3 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 that he is satisfied that the land affected by the rights to be acquired does not exceed 209 square metres in extent, and that the giving of other land in exchange for the rights is unnecessary over the reputed open space land included in the compulsory purchase order mentioned at item 3 below.

THE INQUIRIES will be held by Mr John Watson BSc, FIHT, MICE, MCMI, a person appointed, on the nomination of the Planning Inspectorate, by the Secretary of State for Transport and the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for the purpose of the inquiries into the Orders, and for the purpose of the inquiry in connection with the application for the certificate mentioned below.

THE ORDERS in question are:-

1. The A45 Trunk Road (A45/A46 Tollbar End Junction Improvement) Order 200\_ which was published in draft on 26 March 2009. This is an Order under Sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if made, would provide that certain roads which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along routes described in the Order shall become trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force



2. The A45 Trunk Road (A45/A46 Tollbar End Junction Improvement) Side Roads Order 200\_. which was published in draft on 26 March 2009. This is an Order under Sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 which, if made, would –

- (a) authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to improve highways, stop up highways, stop up private means of access to premises and provide new means of access to premises;

3. The A45 Trunk Road (A45/A46 Tollbar End Junction Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (MP No. XX) 200\_. which was published in draft on 26 March 2009. This is an Order under Sections 239, 240, 246 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980, as extended and supplemented by Section 250 of that Act, and under Section 2 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 which, if made, would authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land and rights over land described in the Schedule to the Order for the purpose of

- a) the construction of the new trunk road in the Parish of Baginton in the District of Warwick, the Parish of Brandon and Bretford in the District of Rugby, all in the County of Warwickshire and in the City of Coventry in pursuance of the Trunk Road Order;
- b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in those parishes and districts in pursuance of the Side Roads Order;
- c) the improvement of the Trunk Road in those parishes and districts;
- d) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road;
- e) use by the Secretary of State for Transport in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned; and
- f) the mitigation of any adverse effects which the existence or use of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved will have on their surroundings.

PROCEEDINGS on the draft Orders are being taken concurrently in accordance with section 257, and paragraph 20 in Schedule 1 to, the Highways Act 1980.

COPIES of the draft Orders and of the plans referred to in them will be deposited together with a copy of a plan showing the reputed open space land, and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge from 23 November 2009, at:

THE INSPECTOR will hear representations from remaining objectors, as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007 so far as concerns the Order numbered 3 above, and statutory objectors as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994 so far as concerns the other Orders named above. He will also, at his discretion, hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

OBJECTORS are reminded that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it; that it will be passed to the Inspector holding the inquiries; and that he may be required to disclose at the inquiries the objection or representation and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the author.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT hereby direct that any person who intends at the inquiries to submit –

- (a) that any highway or proposed highway to which any of the draft Orders relates should follow an alternative route, or
- (b) that instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which a draft Order relates, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route,

shall send to them at the address given below not later than 21 December 2009 sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the person holding the inquiries and the Secretaries of State to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
