

THE A11 TRUNK ROAD (FIVEWAYS TO THETFORD IMPROVEMENT)
SUPPLEMENTARY COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER (NO) 20..

COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN THE PARISHES OF
ICKLINGHAM AND ELVEDEN IN THE DISTRICT OF FOREST HEATH IN
THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has prepared in draft the A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement) Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order (No) 20.. under sections 239, 240 and 246 of the Highways Act 1980 as extended and supplemented by section 250 of that Act and under section 2 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, in addition to the draft A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (No) 20.. If made, the draft Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order will authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the additional land described in the schedule below for the purpose of:

- a) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the Parishes of Icklingham and Elveden in the District of Forest Heath in the County of Suffolk and in pursuance of the A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement Supplementary Side Roads) Order 20..; and
- b) use by the Secretary of State for Transport in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above.

Copies of the draft Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order and of the map referred to therein, together with copies of the draft A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement Supplementary Side Roads) Order 20..

have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 24 September 2009 until 5 November 2009 at the offices of the Highways Agency, Woodlands, Manton Lane, Bedford, MK41 7LW; Suffolk County Council, West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, IP33 3YU; Norfolk County Council, County Hall, Martineau Lane, Norwich, NR1 2DH; Forest Heath District Council, District Offices, College Heath Road, Mildenhall, Suffolk, IP28 7EY; Mildenhall Library, Chestnut Close, Mildenhall, Suffolk, IP28 7NL; and Thetford Library, Raymond Street, Thetford, Norfolk, IP24 2EA. Copies of the draft A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order 20.. and the draft A11 Trunk Road (Fiveways to Thetford Improvement Side Roads) Order 20.. (as originally published on 20 November 2008 and on deposit until 19 March 2009) will also be available to be seen at the above addresses.

Any objection to the draft Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order must be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State at the offices of the Highways Agency, Woodlands, Manton Lane, Bedford MK41 7LW to arrive before 5 November 2009 and should state the title of the Order marked for the attention of Phil Cheesmur (Project Manager) and quoting reference HA 65/19/512. It should give the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of the grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

NOTE: (a) The land comprised in each item in this description is identified on the plan referred to in the draft Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order by means of the number or numbers shown in brackets against that item in this description.

(b) References to ownership are references to ownership or reputed ownership at the time of preparation of the draft Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order and are stated only for the purpose of identification of the land.

In the Parish of Icklingham in the District of Forest Heath

Arable land, parts of Icklingham Byway 1, Parts of Icklingham Byway 7, Elveden Byway 6.

All owned by Elveden Estates (Plots 16/2A, 16/2B, 16/2C, 16/2D)

In the Parish of Icklingham and Elveden in the District of Forest Heath

Part of rough grassland to the north and east of the A11 trunk road

All owned by Elveden Estates (Plots 16/2E, 16/2F, 16/2G, 16/2H)

In the Parish of Elveden in the District of Forest Heath

Part of rough grassland to the west of the A11 trunk road
