

A14 Ellington to Fen Ditton Draft Orders Public Exhibition

A14 Ellington to Fen Ditton

The draft Orders for the A14 Ellington to Fen Ditton scheme were published on 30 September 2009. You are invited to attend an exhibition to view the draft Orders, detailed plans and Environmental Statement that we have developed.

We held Public Information Exhibitions at the end of last year to provide the public an early opportunity to view the detailed plans and seek feedback on the proposed scheme. We have since been finalising our proposals and assessing the environmental impacts of the scheme.

The plans show in detail the line of the road, the structures, drainage provisions, landscaping and other engineering features. The Environmental Statement sets out the effects of the proposed scheme on noise, air quality, landscape, water environment, ecology and nature conservation, cultural heritage and road users. There will be experts on hand at the exhibition to help explain the proposals. Leaflets will be available that explain the compulsory purchase process and what you should do if you wish to comment on any aspect of the scheme.

The period for objections will close on 6 January 2010. Depending upon the number and the nature of any objections, a Public Inquiry may be held before an independent inspector, who will then make recommendations to the Secretary of State for Transport and the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government.

After consideration of objections, representations of support and the inspectors report, the Secretaries of State will decide whether the Orders for the road should be made.

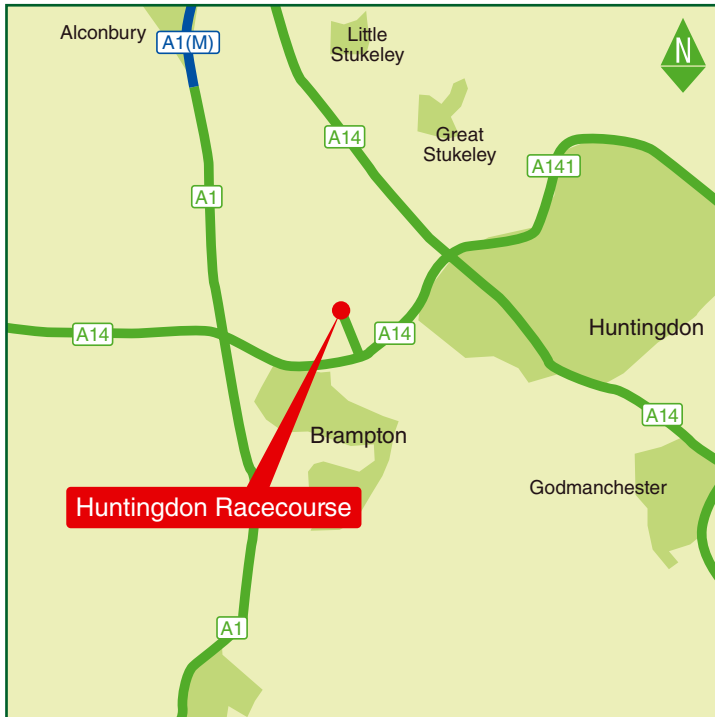

The University Arms Hotel is in the centre of the City, convenient for the Cambridge Bus Station on Drummer Street and city centre car parks are available nearby.

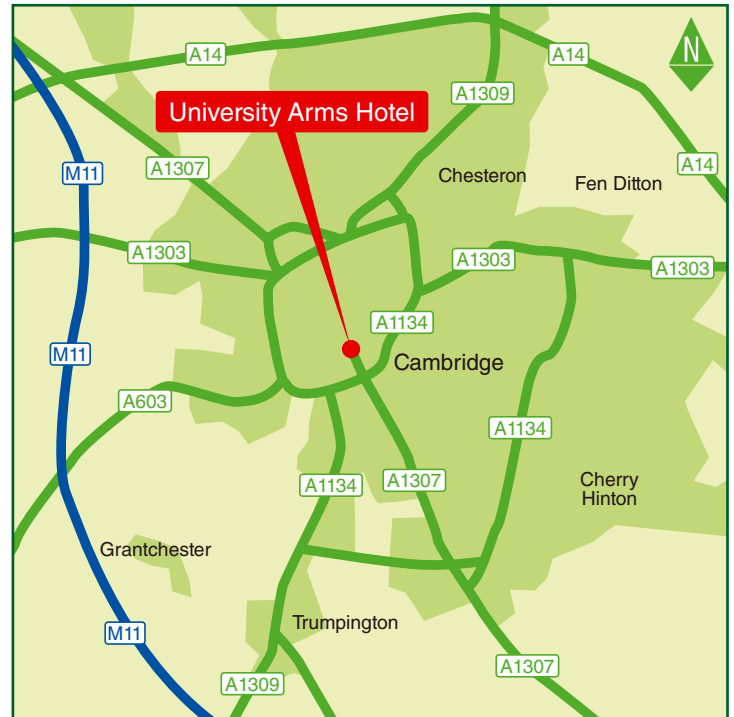


Exhibition Venues Location Plans

Safety at roadworks



The Highways Agency is working with the industry and road users to reduce the risks of working on the roads.

For the safety of roadworkers and all road users, when you are approaching roadworks:

- Keep within the speed limit – it is there for your safety.
- Get into the correct lane in good time – don't keep switching.
- Concentrate on the road ahead, not the roadworks.
- Be alert for works traffic leaving or entering roadworks.
- Keep a safe distance – there could be queues in front.
- Observe all signs – they are there to help you.
